







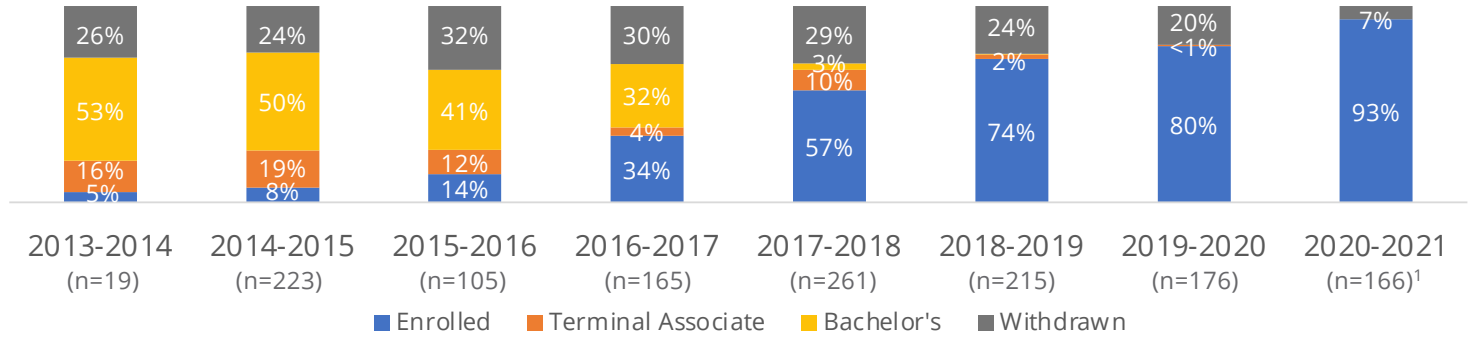

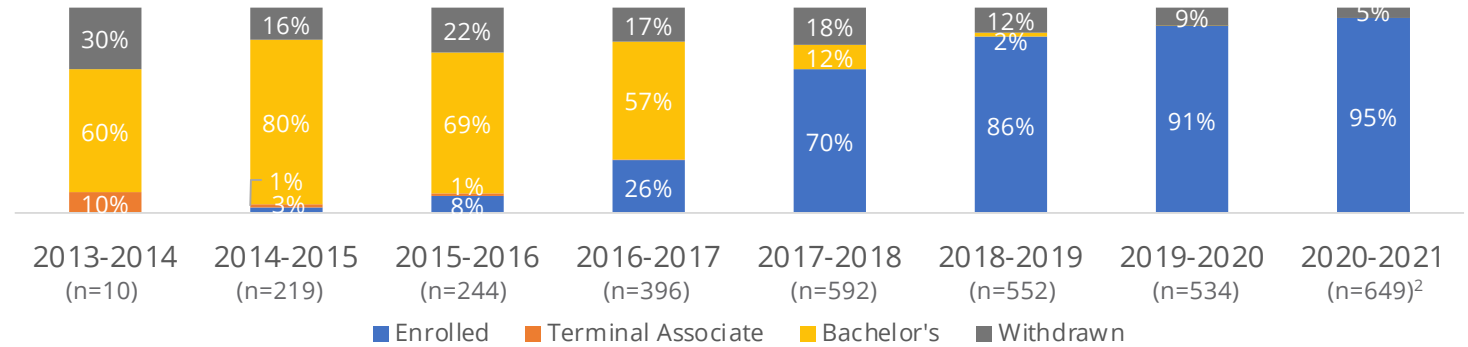
Overall Persistence by Scholarship Type and Academic Year Cohort

76% for First-Time College Students starting at 2-Year Colleges (N=1,330)



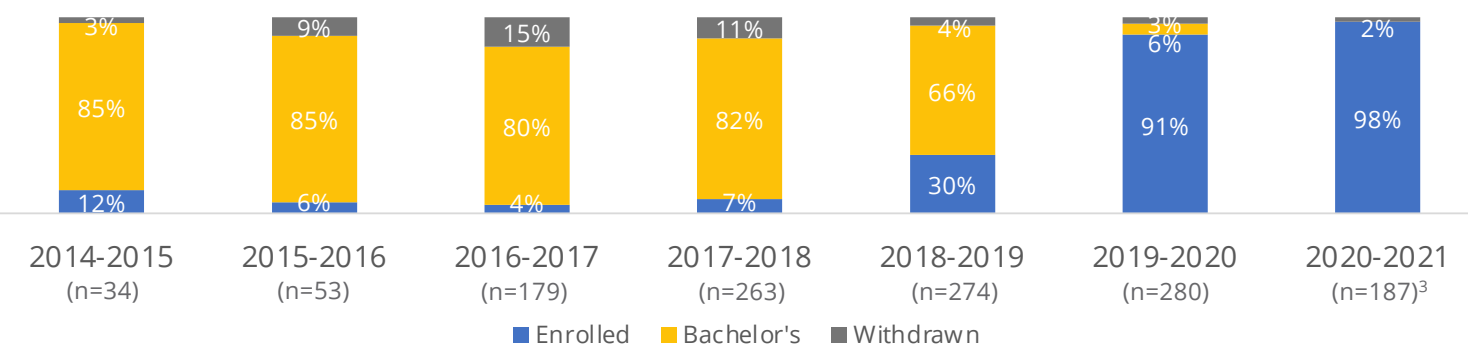
