

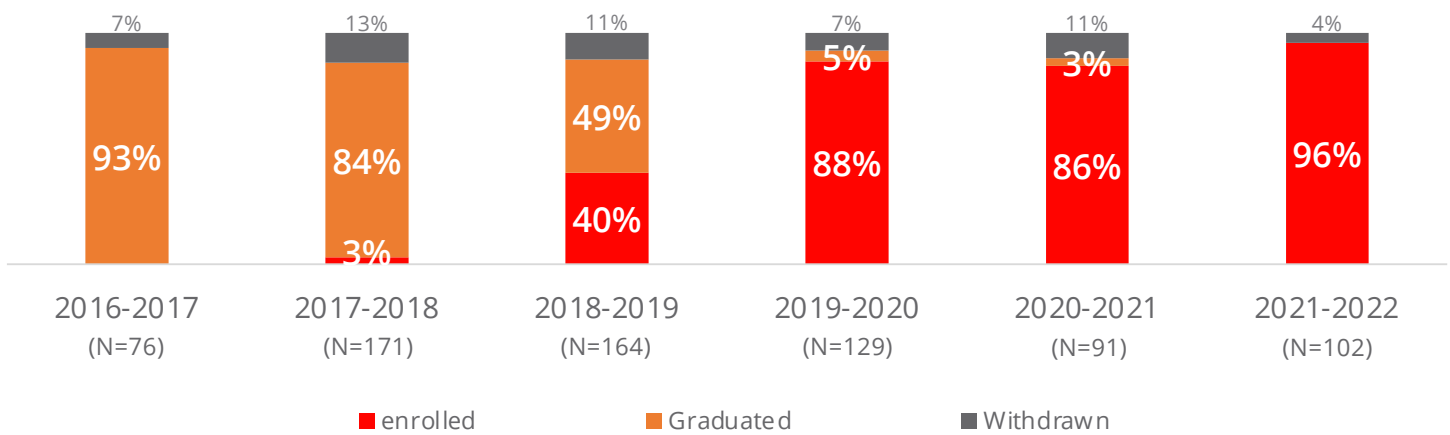

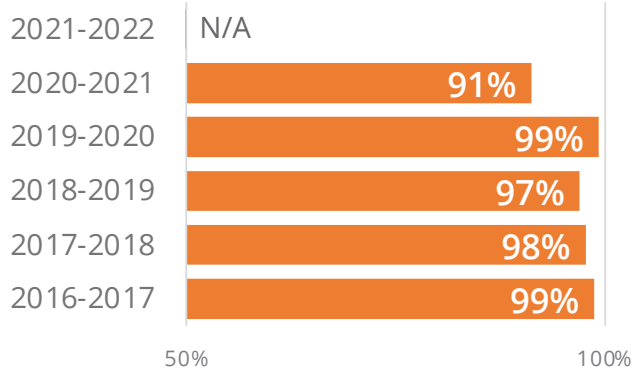

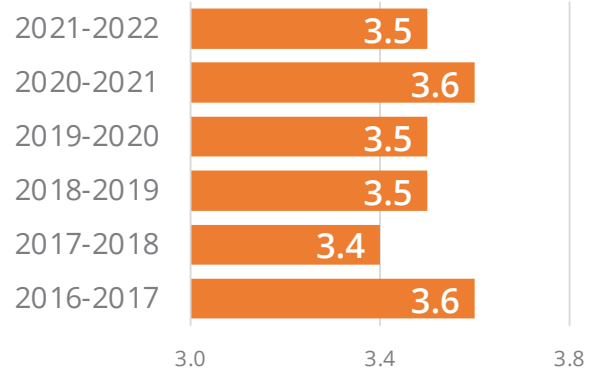
Spring 2022 Persistence by Academic Year Cohort



First-Year Persistence¹

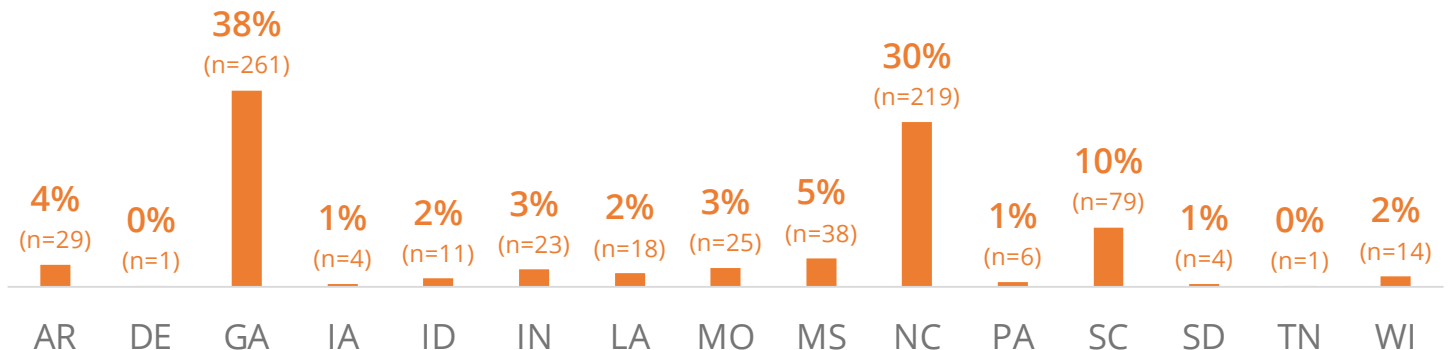


Median Cumulative GPA²
